# ENVIRONMENTAL WATER SAMPLE RESULTS: Total for October 2022: (4) YTD: (6)

- 22-003 Environmental water sample for the Municipal Building 2<sup>nd</sup> floor kitchen was sampled on October 12, 2022. On October 14, 2022, Mrs. Sharp was notified that the environmental sample returned unsatisfactory for total coliform. Mrs. Sharp will retest in one week.
- 22-004 Environmental water sample for the Municipal Building 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor kitchen was re-sampled on October 19, 2022. A satisfactory rating was issued.
- 22-005 Environmental water sample for the Municipal Building 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor bathroom was conducted on October 19, 2022. Mrs. Sharp was notified that the sample was unsatisfactory for coliform bacteria. Mrs. Sharp will retest in November 2022.
- 22-006 Environmental water sample for the Municipal Building 1<sup>st</sup> Floor kitchen was sampled on October 19, 2022. A satisfactory rating was issued on October 19, 2022.

Eurofins QC recommended that the Township take a raw sample from where the water comes into the building. Mr. Toribio will conduct this sample on November 10, 2022.

The NJDEP has notified the Township that they have received two coliform bacteria samples within a two week span. The Township will require to resample for the three weeks in November and complete a form by December 2, 2022. Mrs. Sharp notified Dr. Perez, Jr., Health Officer, of this situation and sent copies of the letter NJDEP sent to the Township for his review. Dr. Perez, Jr., has asked a member of his staff to assist Mr. Toribio in completing the forms to be sent to the State. Mr. Toribio and Mrs. Sharp will be resampling the Municipal Buildings water as recommended in the NJDEP letter.

# **PUBLIC HEALTH**

#### **FLU/COVID CLINIC:**

The Health Department held their annual influenza vaccination clinic on October 4, 2022 from 3 to 7 pm. Atlantic Health administered the flu shots along with booster COVID-19 vaccinations. There were 62 participants with 14 of the 62 who received the Covid vaccination. The Public Health Nurse, Kathy Basile attended the clinic and administered blood pressures.

#### **INQUIRIES-REQUESTS-COMPLAINTS:**

In *October 2022* the Health Department received 0 complaints for animal matters; 3 inquiries from residents regarding, notary services, well water testing, and public health food information; and 8 requests for septic information from realtors, residents, prospective buyers, and engineers/contractors/septic inspectors.

<u>Year-to-date 2022</u>, the Health Department responded to 162 combined complaints/inquiries/requests; as follows:

- 10 complaints dog bites
- 40 inquiries -- regarding home sales, dog licenses and well water testing
- \* 112 requests septic information (as-built and number of bedrooms) from realtors, residents contractors, engineers, etc.

# ANIMAL CONTROL:

### **Dog Licenses**

During the month of **OCTOBER 2022**, the Health Department issued 2 dog licenses during the month of October 2022. The fees to the State totaled \$5.40. For **OCTOBER 2021** a total of 1 dog license was issued during the month of October 2021 with the fees to the State totaling \$1.20.

Year-to-date 2022, a total of 470 dogs have been licensed with five being service dogs and two being replacement licenses for lost tags.
