Resolution TC 23-130 – A Shared Services Agreement by and Between the Township of Harding and the Township of Long Hill Relative to the Services of the Harding Township Administrator Robert Falzarano for Assessment, Report, and Recommendations in Relation to the Long Hill Township Police Department

WHEREAS, Harding has in its employ a certain individual known as Robert Falzarano who has been appointed as the Township Administrator for the Township of Harding; and

WHEREAS, Harding has agreed to permit Mr. Falzarano to act as a consultant for the Township of Long Hill in addition to his duties assigned by Harding to Mr. Falzarano as an employee of Harding; and

WHEREAS, Long Hill has agreed to pay Harding Township a fee of \$10,000.00 upon delivery of the final report for the assessment and evaluation of the administrative operations, facilities, and staffing functions of its police department; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Long Hill has agreed to pay Harding Township an additional sum of \$4,000.00 per month for a period of five years or, until the parties mutually agree that Mr. Falzarano's services are no longer required in the Township of Long Hill; and

WHEREAS, Harding and Long Hill seek to outline the duties and obligations of each party pertaining to Mr. Falzarano's services through a shared services agreement as outlined in N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, *et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, Harding seeks to authorize the execution of the shared services agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Harding (the "<u>Committee</u>") that subject to the following conditions:

1. The Committee hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor, or his/her designee to execute the Shared Services Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, subject to any minor revisions from Counsel.

Resolution TC 23-131 – Resolution Extending the Conditional Redeveloper Designation and Authorizing the Execution of an Amendment to the Conditional Redeveloper Designation and Escrow Agreement with Glen Alpin Preservation Partners, LLC

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023, the Township Committee of Harding Township (the "Township Committee") adopted Resolution #23-066, designating Glen Alpin Preservation Partners, LLC conditional redeveloper (the "Conditional Designation") of the real property located at 685 Mt. Kemble Avenue and designated as Block 34, Lot 1 (the "Glen Alpin Property"), and authorized the execution of a conditional designation and escrow agreement (the "Conditional Redeveloper Designation and Escrow Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Conditional Designation was for a term ending August 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee desires to extend the conditional designation of Glen Alpin Preservation Partners, LLC as the conditional redeveloper of the Glen Alpin Property through December 31, 2023, subject to further good faith negotiation and execution of a redevelopment agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee desires to authorize the execution of an amendment to the Conditional Redeveloper Designation and Escrow Agreement with Glen Alpin Preservation Partners, LLC to permit the parties to continue negotiations of a redevelopment agreement for the Glen Alpin Property.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Harding, County of Morris and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully repeated herein.
- 2. The designation of Glen Alpin Preservation Partners, LLC as conditional redeveloper of the Glen Alpin Property is hereby extended through December 31, 2023, conditioned upon the execution of an amendment to the Conditional Redeveloper Designation and Escrow Agreement.
- 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the amendment to the Conditional Redeveloper Designation and Escrow Agreement.
